

# Stipulation Agreement Provisions



- “Nicor Gas will separate IQ from market rate residential programs in reporting, and will ensure IQ reporting includes a **breakdown of IQ SF and IQ MF.**”
- “Nicor Gas agrees to report on the following metrics in its quarterly reports filed with the Commission, starting January 2022, outside of the Policy Manual update process:  
a) IQ Multifamily Actuals (YTD) i. **Participation – buildings by zip code and apartment units**”
- “Nicor Gas will provide **status reports on joint delivery of whole-building retrofit IQ Programs** with Ameren Illinois no less than twice a year, through its quarterly reporting process.”
- “Nicor Gas agrees to report on the following metrics in its annual reports filed with the Commission, starting January 2022, outside of the Policy Manual update process:  
**a) Program participation, by zip code**”

## Future Metric Discussions



- “Nicor Gas supports the discussion of additional health and safety metrics at SAG for possible inclusion in the Policy Manual.”

- “Nicor Gas commits to define additional equity and affordability reporting metrics with interested stakeholders around energy burden, energy affordability, procedural equity, bill impacts, and other identified areas.”
