1. **CURRENT:** The Illinois Community Action Agencies (CAAs) deliver comprehensive home retrofits to income qualified customers, through the existing IHWAP operations, leveraging both utility incentive funds and Illinois Home Weatherization Assistance Program (IHWAP) grant funds. Joint Funding is defined as Full project cost is shared 50/50. Full measure cost is shared 50/50.

**PROPOSED CHANGE:** CAA's will select which conservation measures will be braided and at what percentages.

**RATIONALE:** CAAs are experts in assessing energy efficiency measures within single and multifamily homes; and mobile homes. Agencies need the flexibility to select which funding sources best match the needed measures for each unit.
