  - For the 2020 EM&V work plan update, will there be any updates to multi-year evaluation plans?
  - Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Data – will AMI data be used in evaluations? If so, for what program(s)?
- **Portfolio-Level Research:**
  - Non-Energy Impact (NEI Research):

    - What items from 2019 being repeated?

    - What new programs will be assessed for NEIs?
- **Evaluation Methods:**

- **Budget:**
  - Provide a breakdown of the 2020 evaluation budget and the general approach for prioritizing resources.
- **Coordination:**
  - Provide information on coordination with other programs, utilities and/or evaluators, as applicable.
