

On March 1, 2025, Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas filed their 2026-2029 Energy Efficiency Plans (“Plan” or “Plan 5”) and the accompanying Stipulation Agreement for approval by the Illinois Commerce Commission (“Commission” or “ICC”). Since that filing, the Clean and Reliable Grid Affordability (“CRGA”) legislation has been enacted, which allows Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas the option to refile Plan 5 to reflect statutory changes applicable to the remaining years of the Plan. Plan 5 is Peoples Gas' and North Shore Gas' fifth energy efficiency plan and covers the four-year period beginning January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2029. Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas intend to revise portions of Plan 5 for Program Years 2027–2029 while maintaining programmatic elements and the overall framework contained in the approved Plan 5. Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas will file revised 2027-2029 Plans with the ICC no later than June 1, 2026.

Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas plan to release a Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit qualified Implementation Contractors to support the remaining three years of the Plan 5 period (Program Years 2027–2029). All respondents should familiarize themselves with the CRGA legislation, the upcoming Revised Plan 5 filing, and accompanying documents.
