March 6 Meeting:

Utilities invited to present current/potential future midstream and upstream programs/measures



April 28 Meeting:

Presentation from Efficiency Vermont and Energy Solutions on midstream / upstream program successes, lessons learned



Deliverable:

Stakeholders propose midstream/upstream *EE Ideas* for utility consideration (midstream and upstream *EE Ideas* presented to large group SAG)

Non-Energy Impacts Working Group

March 5 Meeting:

Follow-up discussion on 2018 economic impact study methodologies; introduce topic of incorporating NEIs into utility cost-effectiveness tests



May 5 Meeting:

Review preliminary NEI study results (Ameren IL and ComEd evaluator research); evaluators present information in memo (forthcoming in April) on how other jurisdictions incorporate NEIs into cost-effectiveness tests; discuss proposed next steps/timing for economic impact studies



July 15 Meeting:

Follow-up discussion on potentially incorporating NEI research results in EE portfolio cost-effectiveness tests in the 2022-2025 EE Portfolio Plans (goal of reaching consensus)



December 8 Meeting:

Discuss preliminary results from income qualified participant NEI Studies for Ameren Illinois and ComEd
