

## **Illinois Energy Efficiency Stakeholder Advisory Group Policy Resolution – 2019 Program Year**

### **Policy Issue: Using the Project Application Date to Determine the IL-TRM Version Followed by the Affordable Housing New Construction Program**

#### **Policy Request:**

For the Affordable Housing New Construction Program, jointly administered with Nicor Gas, Peoples Gas & North Shore Gas, ComEd is interested in confirming stakeholder agreement to continue to:

1. Use the project application date to determine the version of the IL-TRM the ComEd implementation team will follow. This is done in order to confirm the savings calculation methodologies as early as possible in our process due to the long planning horizon for the program.
2. Use the project permit date to determine the applicable version of the Illinois Energy Conservation Code (IL ECC).

#### **Process:**

- SAG held a teleconference meeting on [October 29, 2019](#) for ComEd to share background on this policy request and answer any stakeholder questions.
- No concerns were raised by SAG participants during the October meeting.
- The proposed resolution was circulated to SAG for review on Nov. 1 with 10 Business Days provided for concerns, questions, and/or edits to be raised.
- The SAG Facilitator received no questions or concerns about this policy request. One edit was suggested, to include a reference to evaluators in the policy resolution.
- The SAG Facilitator circulated the final resolution to SAG on December 12, 2019.

#### **Final Resolution (December 2019):**

For the joint utility Affordable Housing New Construction Program, Program Administrators (ComEd, Nicor Gas, Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas) and their independent evaluators will:

1. Use the project application date to determine the version of the IL-TRM the implementation teams will follow. The purpose of this is to confirm the savings calculation methodologies for projects as early as possible due to the long planning horizon for the program.
2. Use the project permit date to determine the applicable version of the Illinois Energy Conservation Code (IL ECC).
