Re: Q1 2017 Evaluation Expenditures

This memorandum provides a summary of evaluation team activities and expenditures in Q1 of 2017 as stipulated in our evaluation contract. The team conducted these activities in support of the evaluation of AIC's Plan 3 Portfolio of Electric and Gas Energy Efficiency Programs.

#### 1. Overview of Evaluation Activities

### 1.1 Key Activities for Q1 2017

In the first quarter of 2017, the evaluation team finalized pending PY8 reports and began PY9 evaluation planning activities. Items of note include:

- Submitted remaining final reports to AIC, ICC staff and the SAG
- Participated in SAG discussions of the PY10 NTG recommendations and 2018 Plan Period
- Wrapped up participation in the TRM V6.0 update process
- Prepared PY8 Evaluation Binders and TRC inputs
- Conducted in-home visits to support the residential Lighting Program
- Continued work on the HVAC incremental cost analysis
- Began developing the formal PY9 evaluation plan through in-person meetings with AIC and implementation team staff

#### 1.2 Upcoming Activities for Q2 2017

In the second quarter of 2017, the evaluation team will complete evaluation planning activities and ramp up program-specific evaluation efforts for the AIC and IPA programs. Items of note include:

- Finalize PY9 evaluation plans for AIC and IPA programs
- Conduct in-depth interviews with program staff and submit data requests for all programs
- Begin to conduct impact analyses for those programs with final program tracking data
- Begin to conduct process evaluation activities for all programs
