





The Need for EE in Multifamily Housing

The Need for EE in Multifamily Housing

EE needs of multifamily renters, by the numbers

87% of multifamily housing is renteroccupied

25-50% of all multifamily renters are low income

Energy expenditures in rentals are 37% higher per sq. ft. than in owner-occupied multifamily


5% of low-income multifamily annual income goes to utility bills (1.5% for higher income multifamily)

22-31% estimated savings per unit in multifamily affordable housing


Research questions we wanted to answer

- What types of programs are available for MF customers to participate in?
- Are the programs available specifically designed for the needs of MF buildings?
- How does MF relate to the rest of the utility EE portfolio?

Electric EE Programs from IOUs in 4 Midwestern States



State Energy Efficiency Policy

Brief overview of policy status in the studied states

Indiana

- EERS adopted 2009 by regulatory order, and overturned 2014 by legislation
- No mandatory standard; EE tied to IRP process
- Voluntary natural gas EE

Ohio

- EERS adopted by legislation in 2008; "frozen" for two years in 2014.
- Currently pending legislation attempting to continue freeze
- EERS is electric only; very limited voluntary gas EE

Minnesota


- Conservation Improvement Program (CIP) since 1991
- Current EERS set by legislation in 2007
- EE required for electric & gas

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
- Decades-long experience with energy efficiency; current policies from 2008
- EE standards set on a utility basis; binding once approved
- EE required for electric & gas











Categories






Key Takeaways from Analysis

- Diverse landscape of multifamily programs
- Diversity of program types increases over time
- Initial offerings to multifamily customers tend to focus on in-unit residential and low-income customers
- Common-area and whole-building programs tend to be adopted in subsequent program years
- Multifamily-Exclusive programs gaining ground in spending and savings

Next Steps

Expanding the Analysis

- Discussion with utility program managers can we find any granular data on levels of multifamily vs. single-family participation in MF-Inclusive programs?
- Expand analysis to include additional states with MF programs – Michigan, Illinois, Wisconsin
- Include natural gas spending and savings where possible, especially for joint electric-gas programs
