SAG Market Transformation Savings Working Group May 10, 2019

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MT Savings Working Group Background

- Purpose of Working Group: To provide a forum to discuss:
 - Market transformation initiatives where the utilities may claim energy efficiency savings and/or other market impacts;
 - What is meant by "market transformation initiative" and;
 - Which market transformation initiatives may be pursued in Illinois?
- The MT Savings Working Group will report-back to the large group SAG, as needed.
- ► Two Phases in 2019:
 - ▶ Phase 1, May to August: Reach agreement on the Framework for Estimating Market Transformation Savings Whitepaper, proposed for inclusion in IL-TRM Version 8.0.
 - ▶ Phase 2, September to December: Discuss savings protocols for MT initiatives, as needed.

Process to Finalize MT Framework

- During today's meeting we will discuss the high-level outline for the Framework for Estimating Market Transformation Savings (MT Framework Whitepaper).
 - ▶ Working Group participants will have 10 Business Days to provide additional comments on the outline presentation.
- ▶ On **Friday, June 14**, the written draft *MT Framework Whitepaper* will be presented to the Working Group for discussion.
 - Working group participants will have 10 Business Days to provide additional comments on the written draft whitepaper.

Process to Finalize MT Framework (cont.)

- ▶ On **Wed.**, **July 17** an updated *MT Framework Whitepaper* will be presented, incorporating feedback.
 - Any additional feedback from July 17th meeting will be considered for incorporation in whitepaper.
 - ► The updated "final draft" MT Framework Whitepaper will be circulated to SAG by July 24, with 10 Business Days for comment.
- On Mon., August 12 we will discuss any SAG comments on the MT Framework Whitepaper.
 - Any additional feedback from August 12th meeting will be considered for incorporation in whitepaper.
 - Important Note: To be included in IL-TRM Version 8.0, the Working Group needs to send VEIC the final MT Framework by August 22nd.

Phase 2 Activities (Fall 2019)

- Meet on September 11th to discuss residential code study results (from MEEA/Cadmus Baseline Assessment).
- Meet on November 20th to discuss commercial code study results (from MEEA/Cadmus Baseline Assessment).
- Note: I anticipate scheduling initiative-specific MT savings protocols for discussion during the Sept. and Nov. meetings, as needed.
