Additional lighting measures included by Ameren

CFL reflector flood lamps – \$4
LED recessed down lamps – \$30
Ceramic Metal Halide Integral ballast lamps (flood lamps) – \$10
Pulse Start Metal Halide 750 W – \$75
Daylight dimming systems
8-foot High Performance T8 – \$10
T5 lamps – same \$7-10 as HPT8s

Additional lighting measures included by DCEO

LED traffic signals – \$75-90 LED traffic arrows – \$20-35 LED pedestrian modules – \$30-35

Different lighting incentive levels

Metal Halide – ComEd/DCEO offers incentives of \$20, \$35, \$40 depending on size, while Ameren offers \$40 for all sizes except 750 W

Permanent Lamp Removal – ComEd/DCEO offers \$6-\$16 depending on size and reflector, while Ameren offers up to \$15 to be determined

Controls – ComEd/DCEO offers \$0.10 per W controlled, while Ameren offers \$25-\$50 per control depending on the type

Highbay Fixture Replacement – ComEd/DCEO offers \$0.40/W reduced, while Ameren allows applicant to choose between \$0.40/W and fixed incentive of \$35-50 per fixture

Fluorescent Fixtures with Reflectors – ComEd/DCEO offers \$7-10, while Ameren adds \$2, for an incentive of \$9-12 if reflectors are included

LED Exit Signs – incentives are identical, but Ameren would like to revisit level in the future
