#### ComEd Strategy / Approach

- ✓ ComEd believes that a community approach to delivering energy efficiency programs needs to be explored
- ✓ We have developed a two-prong approach / strategy
  - 1. Within the City of Chicago, find ways to leverage City resources, skills, etc to support both ComEd's and the City's objectives
  - 2. Outside the City, develop an approach to work within the many municipalities and communities in ComEd's service territory.

# ComEd's Objectives -

- ✓ Increase the delivery of cost-effective energy efficiency initiatives in communities throughout the ComEd service territory
- ✓ Meet all regulatory requirements for cost recovery
- ✓ Develop and implement a replicable pilot project that assists communities in meeting their climate change and other sustainability objectives



#### **Program Approach**

- Establish partnerships with key municipal groups and individual municipalities
  - Metropolitan Mayors Caucus
  - US Conference of Mayors
  - Clinton Climate Initiative
- Develop a project approach that will result in municipal action that supports energy efficiency
  - Simple & Replicable
  - High Profile
  - Attracts external resources
- ✓ Projects must maintain or, preferably, increase the costeffectiveness of the ComEd programs
  - Lower cost through cost-sharing
  - Increase productivity / penetration rate
- ✓ Expected Approach Municipality vs. Municipality contest
