## Santa Fe County, New Mexico

Launch date: April 2010



- Team: Renewable Funding, Modral Sperling, Citigroup
- \* Eligible projects: renewable energy only
- Includes the County and cities within the County

## Los Angeles County, California

Launch Date: Summary 2010



- Program encompasses up to 88 cities, over 10 million people
- Program team to deliver marketing, administration, quality assurance, workforce training, and other efforts
- Renewable Funding is PACE program administrator. Broader team includes: BKi, Build it Green, The Energy Coalition and South Bay Environmental Service Centers
- Eligible projects: residential and commercial RE, EE, water efficiency

### Illinois PACE Legislation: SB2505

#### SB2505 passed the Senate 37-11 on April 15<sup>th</sup>

- Lead sponsor Sen. Michael Frerichs
- Bill in House Revenue & Finance Committee
  - Lead sponsor Rep. Lou Lang
- Illinois Finance Authority may create a statewide PACE program that counties and municipalities could join.
- CMAP Received USDOE Retrofit Ramp-Up Grant
  - Possible focus on PACE financing

# Integrating PACE & Utility EE Programs

- PACE can finance balance remaining after all governmental and utility incentives are applied to project costs.
- PACE programs and utility programs can actively crosspromote their programs to increase energy savings.
- Utilities subject to EEPS may be permitted to count PACE-financed EE savings toward EEPS mandates, increasing energy savings without increasing rates.
- But, utilities should only be credited if they materially support and promote PACE programs, yielding greater energy savings that would have otherwise occurred.
