Current & Potential Near-Term Measures

- ✓ Current Measure
 - ENERGY STAR[®] Qualified Refrigerators offered at select Sears stores
 - Launched OBF program on June 20, 2011
- ✓ Potential Near-Term Measures (2012)
 - High efficiency top-load clothes washers
 - Retailer approach
 - Central air conditioning replacement
 - Contractor approach
 - Both of these measures align with current and upcoming incentive programs within the Smart Ideas For Your Home (SIFYH) portfolio



How Are We Doing with Refrigerators?

- ✓ Currently, our OBF program has:
 - 60 approved applicants totaling \$65k in committed funds
 - 50 loans have been funded; \$52k
 - 3 have been approved; \$3.4k
 - 7 are pending; \$10k
 - Funded = Paperwork from customer received, unit delivered, and loan finalized by AFC.
 - Approved = Customer selected unit at the store, signed and returned all necessary paperwork, and is scheduled for delivery.
 - o Pending = Customer application was approved and preapproval letter sent to customer. Waiting for return of loan documents from customer.
 - Program operations are running smoothly



Our Retailer Approach

- ✓ Signed on with Sears as our participating retailer
 - Seventeen stores across a wide geographic area
 - Stores are part of ComEd's Fridge & Freezer Recycling Rewards Program
- ✓ Additional retailers being pursued for 2012





Why Sears?

- Sears holds roughly a 40 percent market share of appliance sales in the Chicagoland area
- Sears has a wide geographic distribution of stores that would allow favorable customer reach within ComEd's service territory
- Sears is also a program partner with ComEd's Fridge & Freezer Recycling Rewards program (formerly Appliance Recycling)
 - Past operational experience = better program efficiency

Energy Efficiency Loans Now Available



ComEd is one of five Illinois utilities offering Energy Efficiency Loans, along with Ameren Illinois, Nicor, Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas. Each Utility may have energy efficient products that qualify for these loans. Customers can view all the detailed information at <u>ILEnergyLoan.com</u> and check out the products available from each utility. Some restrictions apply.

For ComEd Customers

Utility Energy Efficiency Loans provide eligible homeowners, duplex owners, condominium owners, and residential building owners with four units or less, special financing for the purchase of approved high efficiency ENERGY STAR® qualified refrigerators through participating Sears stores. ENERGY STAR® qualified refrigerators with a store advertised price of \$1,200 or less, plus tax, delivery, and the replacement of a water hose if needed, qualify for this program.

Example: If you qualify for a loan for a \$1,200 refrigerator plus tax and delivery over a ten year term, you will typically see a loan installment, including interest of less than \$20 added each month to your ComEd bill.

residential building owners (four units or less) with special financing for the purchase of approved highefficiency ENERGY STAR® qualified refrigerators through participating Sears locations. ENERGY STAR® refrigerators with an instore advertised price of \$1,200 or less plus tax, delivery and the replacement of a water hose, if needed, qualify for this
program.

Example: If you qualify for a \$1,200 refrigerator (plus tax and delivery) over a ten year term, you will typically see a loan installment (including interest) of less than \$20 added each month to your ComEd bill.

Is An Energy Hungry **Refrigerator** Eating Into Your Budget?



A new, more energy efficient refrigerator might be what you need.

ComEd homeowners, duplex owners, and residential buildings owners with up to four units may be eligible for a special Energy Efficiency Loan for the purchase of an approved high efficiency ENERGY STAR[®] qualified refrigerator. Funds are limited and available on a firstcome, first-served basis.

Utility Energy Efficiency Loans are available while funding lasts!

Here is how it works:

- For loan details go to ComEd.com/EnergyLoan or call (800-334-7661).
- · Pre-qualify to finance your refrigerator purchase.
- ENERGY STAR[®] qualified refrigerators with a store advertised price of \$1,200 or less qualify for the program.
- Participation in ComEd's Smart Ideas® Fridge & Freezer Recycle Rewards Program is required and includes pick up and recycling of your old working refrigerator and you will receive a \$35 check from ComEd.
- · A credit score of 640 or greater is required.
- Visit a participating Sears store to purchase your eligible ENERGY STAR[®] qualified refrigerator.
- Your new refrigerator loan installment will be billed each month on your ComEd electricity bill as "Energy Efficiency Loan." The minimum loan amount is \$500.

Example: If you qualify for a \$1,200 refrigerator plus tax and delivery, over a ten year term, for most refrigerators the monthly loan installments could be less than \$20 including interest, currently at 4.99%. Note the installation of a new water line, or service contracts, are not eligible for the Energy Efficiency Loan.

- What are the eligibility requirements? You must be a ComEd homeowner, duples
- owner, condominium owner or a residential building owner with up to four units. You must be a current ComEd customer with

- an active ComEd account number. · You must have a credit score of 640 or greater.
- You must purchase your refrigerator from a participating Sears's store (visit ILEnergyLoan.com for a list of store locations).
- The refrigerator must be ENERGY STAR® qualified with a store advertised price of \$1,200 or less.
- Minimum loan amount is \$500.
- You must participate in ComEd's Smart Ideas® Fridge and Freezer Recycle Rewards Program.

How will I be billed?

Loan installments will be listed on your monthly ComEd bill as "Energy Efficiency Loan." It may take up to two billing periods to see your loan installment on your ComEd bill.

What happens if I move?

If you move, the entire balance of the loan will be due with your last ComEd bill at that address. The loan will not transfer to your new account in the ComEd service territory.

Can I pay more than my installment amount each month?

No, if you pay more than your monthly bill and installment amount, the extra dollars will be applied to your ComEd electricity service.

Will I see my balance on the ComEd bill each month?

No, your loan installment will be listed on your monthly ComEd bill under the line item "Energy Efficiency Loan." To find out your balance, call 888-269-3133.

Will I be charged interest for this loan?

Yes, interest charges will apply – see loan application for terms.

What is the maximum term of the loan?

The maximum term of the loan can be up to 10 years.

Can failure to pay my monthly installment affect my ComEd account?

Yes, failure to pay your monthly installment, as well as partial payments, can result in loss of electricity service. Late fees may apply.

What if I pay my monthly installment but fail to pay for electricity service?

Payments will be applied to your monthly ComEd electric service bill first and the balance will be applied to your installment. If your payment exceeds your monthly electricity and loan installment, the remaining balance will be applied to your electric service on your next ComEd bill. Partial payments can result in loss of electric service and late fees may apply.

What is ComEd's Smart Ideas® Fridge and Freezer Recycle Rewards Program?

Your participating Sears store will pick up your old refrigerator for free and recycle it in an environmentally friendly way. You will receive a check for \$35 from ComEd for your recycled refrigerator. For information, visit ComEd.com/ FridgeRecycling.


