Action Items

PG-NSG Q3 Report-Out; PY5 Update

PG-NSG is exploring smart t-stat installations through Home Energy Jumpstart Program.
 It will not necessarily be limited to Nest. PG-NSG is issuing an RFP this week, to manufacturers. There will be a customer co-pay of \$100. This is likely to roll-out August 1st, as a pilot. It's still largely un-tested in the market, which is why it's a pilot. Also to

ensure that home systems work. Savings are unknown; PG-NSG will be working with Navigant soon to discuss. Whitepapers in the market range broadly for the smart t-stat. Pilot will be funded through R&D budget / Emerging Technologies budget.

- PG-NSG is planning 15,000 Home Energy Audits in PY5; right now planning 1,500 smart t-stats.
- Home Energy JumpStart share link to video on meeting materials page.

Nicor Gas Q3 Report-Out; PY5 Update

- HEER program has exceeded PY4 therm goal, due to increased demand for 95% and 97% furnaces. Furnace rebate will be reduced and 92% rebate eliminated in PY5.
- Update on residential incentive changes for PY5.
- No action items.

Definition of "Breakthrough Equipment and Devices"

- Not consensus: Process
 - Ameren IL / PG-NSG want to wait until the definition is agreed-upon to decide next step/filing.
- Not consensus: Definition
 - Whether to keep a reference to "that the Program Administrator determines."
- No action items.

EE Successes Fact Sheet Report-out (Jim Jerozal, Nicor Gas)

- Keith Martin, Ameren IL: Has the group included savings to date? Is it difficult for people
 to understand lifetime savings? How do others report this type of data (ACEEE)? We
 need to make sure the jobs number is correct when we put it out there. We should be
 careful with indirect jobs.
 - Jobs support = created and retained
 - Chris Neme, Energy Futures Group: Lifetime savings to date may not be an easy calculation to make. Suggestion to include a levelized cost per kWh, cost per therm.
 - What are the cumulative persisting annual savings?
 - Can this number be reported out of utility tracking systems?
 - Jennifer Morris, ICC Staff: Isn't this data in the portfolio C/E results?
 - Chris Neme, Energy Futures Group: This would be needed for each measure.
 - Rob Kelter, ELPC: You are representing lifetime savings that haven't happened yet; be careful how this is communicated.
- Rob Kelter, ELPC: Legislators don't care about the jobs number. They are inundated with huge jobs numbers.
 - o Chris Neme, Energy Futures Group: We should have the best estimate we can.
 - Anne McKibbin, Elevate Energy: Concerned this is inconsistent with other jobs estimates.
- What about the \$ that is NOT spent due to savings? Shouldn't that be a reduction in jobs?
- Chris Neme, Energy Futures Group: Is there any evaluation data on the average participant / how many bulbs they purchased, to include a residential participation number for lighting programs?
 - Roger Baker, ComEd: Concerned that this estimate number would not be reasonable/reliable.

- Phil Mosenthal, Optimal Energy: Include % of population so that people understand the impacts.
- Rob Kelter, ELPC: Concerned about including OPower customers.
 - o Keith Martin, Ameren IL: Agrees; they are opt-in customers.
- Communities Served (map with participation dots around Illinois):
 - o Keith Martin, Ameren IL: This is a wonderful message, that the EE programs are universal throughout the state.
 - Sue Nathan, AEG: Another message is to show participation increase by year, to see the growth.
- Chris Neme, Energy Futures Group: For \$ invested how much did customers contribute? Can that be shown as well? To make the point that private sector investments are being leveraged.
- Karen Lusson, IL AG: Shouldn't the number be bigger, for the OPower program?
 - That program didn't begin until the most recent program year (those numbers are not yet included – will be included in Version 2).
- Karen Lusson, IL AG: Suggestion to see a translation of energy savings into \$ for consumers. Dollars saved for consumers.
 - Karen Winter-Nelson (SEDAC) has been working on this. Phil Mosenthal and Chris Neme offered to assist.
- Chris Neme, Energy Futures Group: Suggests breaking "performance" into energy bill savings and environmental benefits.
- Job multiplier webinar meeting (teleconference) invitation to be sent to the full SAG.
- Successes Subcommittee to follow-up on suggestions; update Successes Fact Sheet.

Nicor Gas Wasted Energy Study (Chris Vaughn, Nicor Gas)

- Rob Kelter, ELPC: Are the technical potential numbers available?
 - Numbers are still being finalized; Nicor Gas will share when they are final.
