Updated Portfolio Summary

- ComEd's portfolio summary reflects certain adjustments from the March version
 - Reduced overall budget due to updated load forecasts (showing reduced energy deliveries)
 - AC tuneups removed from C/I portfolio
 - Low-income budget increased
 - Refined portfolio-level costs

Key Changes: Residential Programs

- Most programs are similar in design to currently-run programs
- Residential Demand Response program added for PY10 only
 - Mandate from Plan 3 Order
- Low-mod Income programs added
 - Low Income programs w/Peoples Gas
 - Mod Income programs w/Nicor

Key Changes: Business Programs

- Most programs unchanged in design from currently running programs
- Strategic Energy Management is modestly expanded
- Assessment program added
 - Feeder into othe programs
 - Captures operational savings
- LED Streetlighting Program added

Key Changes: SAG Portfolio Planning Process

- Most changes from prior version reflect settlement items
 - Annual Goal increased to 510 GWh from 435 GWh
 - Low Income program funding increased to \$4.3 million/yr (in addition to DCEO-administered)
 - Demand Response Program added for PY10

- Plan draft undergoing internal review
- Filing on September 1
 - Triggers 5 month deadline for Commission Action
- Consensus Stipulation Agreement with nonfinancially interested stakeholders
