


Our Income Eligible Program Philosophy - Amended

- ✓ Use a whole-building approach to increase efficiency.
 - Explore structuring incentives to reward higher levels of efficiency
- ✓ Offer programs that benefit owners and renters
- ✓ Offer customers multiple ways to participate
- ✓ Include customer education in every program
- ✓ Leverage sources of funding for health & safety improvements or measures not covered by utility (e.g., IL HWAP)
- ✓ Partner with organizations already working with targeted populations
- ✓ **Strengthen Communities** not just by weatherizing homes but also by supporting the community as a whole (e.g., *hiring people from the community*)

- 8. Residential Lighting Discounts IE
 - Deeper Discounts at Stores in IE Areas
- 9. Residential Behavior IE
 - Income eligible Behavioral program with O-Power;
 To be tested in Emerging Technologies






Energy Savings over Four Years - Residential






Budget over Four Years - Residential
