- RNC was close to target but new challenges identified
  - RNC cost-effectiveness is a business challenge
- Behavior is launching in 2019

  - Alsip Mini Mills project delayed due to fire
    - 500K Gross Therms
    - \$350K incentive
- BNC developing new pipeline
- BEER projects delayed until 2019

- Achieved 67.5% of forecasted therm goal
- Utilized 80.8% of forecasted budget
- Lack of production is attributed to delayed Custom projects

### **Program Specific Overview**

- Slow start-up in 2018
- 9 out of 16 CAAs participated in 2018
- Inaccurate forecasting
- Braided DOE and HHS funding w/EEP funding proved to be difficult

#### **Sector Overview**

- 241 single family homes received assistance
- Public housing authority received assistance for 189 units
- Zero safety incidents

### 2019 Adjustments



### **Changes Made**

- Diversifying the workforce w/ contractor channel in IQ Program
  - Utilizing a broader net of 5013C agencies (Catholic Charities, Rebuilding Together)
- Expanding Business Custom efforts to increase Public Sector Outreach

### **Improved Results**

- IQ spending increased \$2.3M in Q1
  - New IQ contractor channel will spend \$3M
  - Enhanced pipeline of IQ projects
  - 20% to goal of weatherization for SF
- Will penetrate over 3K MF units in contractor channel
- 132 IQ homes weatherized in Q1 vs. 241 for all of 2018





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
