Re: Public Sector Program Net-to-Gross Recommendations for CY2018

Recommendations

This memo presents Navigant's net-to-gross (NTG) recommendations for CY2018 public sector programs. These programs were previously administered by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) and will be incorporated into ComEd Business Programs in CY2018.

Navigant recommends that these public-sector programs use ComEd PY10 NTG ratios for comparable Business Programs that have been deemed by the IL Stakeholders Advisory Group (SAG) for CY2018¹. These values are shown in Table 1. Navigant will not separate NTG ratios for public sector and private sector projects, but recommends conducting research to calculate separate ratios for future programming.

NTG Research

For CY2018, Navigant will not differentiate between public and private sector projects in NTG calculations and will employ the above NTG ratios for both sectors. However, Navigant intends to conduct research in CY2018 by stratifying the NTG samples so that we can calculate separate NTG ratios for private and public sectors.

Additionally, the PHA Efficient Living program has historically seen a deemed NTG ratio of 1.0 because the program targeted the income-eligible sector. However, because income-eligible customers are not typically the decision makers for this program, Navigant recommends conducting NTG research on this program in CY2018 and believes the TRM NTG Working Group should consider whether the PHA Program should be included with other programs targeted at the income eligible sector that have a deemed NTG ratio of 1.0.
