Challenges in Program Ye Low Income Programs

- In the Low Income Retrofit Program, the cover enough of the measure costs, du requirements
- Public Housing Authorities fell thro offerings, neither fitting Public Secto Programs as designed
- The definition of low income household (
 level) precluded many projects and caused con
- Difficulty in getting grants in place due to require interagency agreements, legal review, varying structures, changes in agencies, etc.

Recommendations for Program Year

Public Sector Programs

- Increase incentives by about 10%
- Increase maximum project to \$200,000.
- Add special category for outdoor light
- Set earlier date to receive Final App
- Add measures to standard list LED lighting, additional controls
- · Add "but for" statement to certification
- Consider adding additional categories such private schools and universities
- Use ARRA programs (SEP and EECGB) to expa EEPS and develop projects
- · Expand outreach efforts through IML, ILARC, etc.

Recommendations for Program Year

Low Income Programs

- Develop program targeted at Public Housing Authorities
- Provide greater flexibility in determining incention levels for each measure, depending on actual program costs
- Put on hold Moderate Rehab Program
- Revise definition of low income based or \$8215 80 AMI vs. 150% of poverty level
