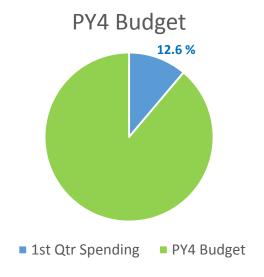

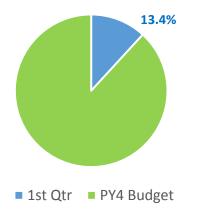
# Residential Highlights PY4 Q1

Residential Budget PY4



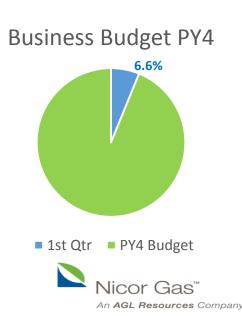




## **Business Highlights PY4 Q1**

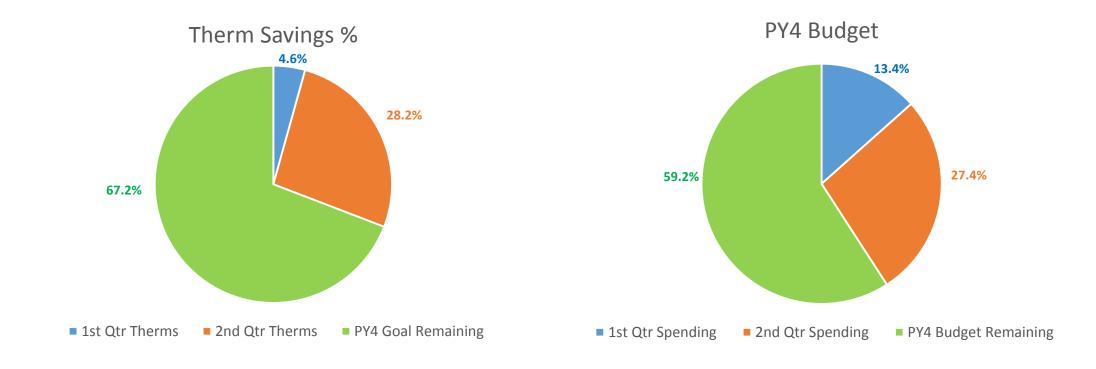

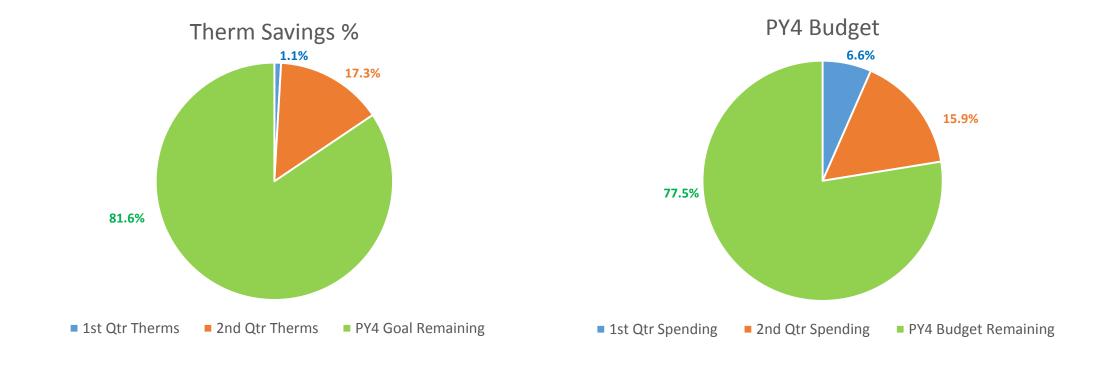
